Reports of Committee Members: Lou Candura

Apparel: Chris Morgan. Order for on hand apparel made for registration and beyond. Lots of sweatshirts, hats, shorts, long sleeves. Trying not to keep as much on hand this year. After registration will look to do first online store. Two new logos and new designs will be incorporated.

Fundraising: Megan Mooney. Friday June 7th is Golf outing. Will have DJ and putting contest. Costs have gone up due to new ownership. Cost will increase from \$150 (prior to May 1st) and \$175 (after). Board members voted to approve the pricing. Each level will provide a raffle basket. We will look to call upon local businesses and contact for sponsorships. New scoreboard this year. Looking at 2-4 sponsors for lifetime advertising. Two or three are already lined up. \$2500 to \$3k per sponsor. Banners on the back of the bleachers will be about \$250 each. We are looking to sell 12. Cost is \$40 for the banner.

Concessions: Nothing at this time.

Flag Football: New promotion. \$99 registration fee prior to May 1st. \$149 fee after May 1st. Pre-K and K combined, Grades 1 and 2 combined. Need 4 head coaches and many Assistants.

Registration/Events: Communication went out for registration. April 6th and April 13th. 830 -11am. Working on signs to put out and put around town as well. Some varsity players will be in attendance. Motoin for player referral program for \$25 gift card to OMG. Board member approved unanimously.

Board reviewed two samples for uniforms. Riddell was approved by the board to use. Reversible jersey, game pants, socks, practice pants are all in negotiations. Pants should last 3-5 years. Price to be \$125-135 approximately. We will try to have mock ups for the registration.

Wayne, Morristown and Sparta were voted in. There will be three conferences. Where teams fall in each conference is still up in the air. 150+ will be in the "Liberty" Conference. (5 heavies on the line) 120-150 will be middle conference (3 heavies on the line). Less than 120 will be Freedom Conference. Hanover Park left the league. More to come here. Good news is that league is growing and numbers in most programs are rising. High school coaches pushing for alignment with High School schedules. Girls flag is consideration to be added to MCYFL program.

Need to move quickly to get new scoreboard lined up. 8-9 week turnaround time currently. Could go to 10-12 weeks if we wait much longer. \$8500 for the scoreboard and \$3700 for labor. Payment terms under negotiation
